

**John T. Jost** is Professor of Psychology at New York University. His research addresses stereotyping, prejudice, political ideology, and system justification theory. He has published over 80 articles and book chapters. In 2007 he was named one of the five most highly cited associate professors in social-personality psychology. Other honors include the ISPP Erik Erikson Early Career Award in Political Psychology, SPSP Theoretical Innovation Prize, and SPSSI Gordon Allport Intergroup Relations Prize (three times). Jost is Editor of the Oxford University book series in Political Psychology and has served on several editorial boards and executive committees of professional societies.
