

Bert Klandermans is Professor of Applied Social Psychology at the VU-University, Amsterdam, the Netherlands. He has published extensively on the social psychology of social movements. He is the editor of *Social Movements, Protest, and Contention*, the prestigious book series of the University of Minnesota Press. His *Social Psychology of Protest* appeared with Blackwell in 1997. He is the editor and co-author (with Suzanne Staggenborg) of *Methods of Social Movement Research* (University of Minnesota Press, 2002), (with Nonna Mayer) of *Extreme Right Activists in Europe* (Routledge, 2006), and (with Conny Roggeband) of *Handbook of Social Movements Across Disciplines*. Springer, 2007. He served the ISPP in several roles; most recently as vice-president.
