

Thomas Rudolph is Associate Professor of Political Science at the University of Illinois. His research program is concentrated in the fields of political psychology and public opinion. He is the co-author of *Expression vs. Equality: The Politics of Campaign Finance Reform*. His work has appeared in the *American Journal of Political Science*, the *Journal of Politics*, *Political Psychology*, and other top journals. Professor Rudolph has been an active member of ISPP for nine years.
