

2-year post-doc position at the University of Geneva

We are looking to hire a postdoctoral researcher for our project, Fostering Resilience: Evaluating Intergroup Interventions in Preventing Ethnic Polarization in Post-Conflict Contexts. This project focuses on the impact of contentious commemorations on intergroup relations in Bosnia and Herzegovina and tests the effectiveness of various intergroup interventions aimed at preventing ethnic polarization. We are looking for candidates who have completed a PhD in political or social psychology, political science, or related fields and who have a strong background in research on intergroup conflicts. In addition, the person should have well-developed methodological skills, notably in statistical analysis and the elaboration of experimental designs and surveys.

The position is for two years, starting in January 2025. The selected candidate will be affiliated with the Department of Political Science and International Relations and the Swiss Center for Affective Sciences at the University of Geneva.
