

CfP: Inclusive Citizenship as Belongings, Practices and Acts

Submission Deadline: 1 June 2022

The Leibniz Research Center for Inclusive Citizenship and the European Consortium for Political Research's Standing Group on Citizenship are calling for paper and poster proposals for their joint international conference on the theme "Inclusive Citizenship as Belongings, Practices and Acts". The goal of the conference is to examine various aspects of inclusion and citizenship as belongings, practices, and acts.

When and where: 29 September – 1 October 2022, Leibniz University Hannover, Germany

Scope: Under the theme Inclusive Citizenship as Belongings, Practices and Acts, the conference aims to bring together scholars and practitioners analysing citizenship as a social practice from a range of perspectives, focusing on six areas: Cultural heritage and citizenship; digitalisation and digital citizenship; inclusive citizenship education; gender, migration, and citizenship; medical citizenship; teaching, learning and citizenship.
