La Moneda Palace is the seat of Chilean government. The President of the Republic and the most important ministries operate there. You can register on the official site and access to guided tours Monday through Friday between 9 am and 5 pm. A must-see is the guard changing ceremony, which takes place every two days, at 10 am on weekdays and 11 on weekends, in Plaza de la Constitution.

METRO STATION: La Moneda, L1.

Plaza de Armas was built as the center of the city at the time of its founding in 1541, and today is one of its most important cultural spaces.

There you can see historical buildings as the Cathedral of Santiago, the Chilean Post Office, the National History Museum and the present building of the Municipality of Santiago.

The San Cristobal Hill

The San Cristóbal Hill stands at about 880 meters tall, serving as a key landmark. From its summit, visitors can enjoy breathtaking panoramic views of Santiago and the Andes. At its peak lies the Sanctuary of the Immaculate Conception, featuring a striking statue of the Virgin Mary. You can also visit fantastic attractions such as the Cable Car and the Funicularthat who are located near the hill.

This site is a favorite among both locals and tourists, who visit for outdoor activities like hiking and biking.
